NOTIFICATION

Sub: Criteria for filling up of vacant seats by the rank holders of Merit List for admission to 1st year of Diploma Courses in Self-financed Polytechnics in the State for the Academic Year 2020-21

Government in the Department of Technical Education, Training & Skill Development under Memo No. 101550/2020 (File No. TETSD-14099/26/2020-ESTT SEC-Dept. of TET&SD) dated 01.10.2020, issued a guideline for admission to the 1st year courses of Diploma Engineering in Self-Financed Polytechnics under Management Quota for the academic session 2020-21.

Accordingly, WBSCT&VE&SD conducted online counseling in three phases for admission of candidates to all polytechnics including self-financed polytechnics under its affiliation, based on the Provisional Merit List published by WBSCT&VE&SD. After completion of counselling process, it has been noticed that certain seats of 1st year, which were due to be filled-up through counselling, as well as the seats under Management Quota (1st year only) in various Self-financed Polytechnics are lying vacant.

For extending the opportunity to the candidates who have secured ranks in the Provisional Merit Lists for admission to 1st year Diploma Courses, and in pursuance of the order issued by the Technical Education, Training & Skill Development under Memo No. 991(2)-TET(Poly)/14A-01/2019 dated 09.08.2019, the WBSCT&VE&SD hereby accord approval to the Management of Self-Financed Polytechnics to fill-up the vacant seats based on the marks obtained by the applicants as per the following criteria, from amongst the applicants by giving open advertisement in newspapers or in their official website or through other modes:-

1. The first preference should be given to the valid rank holders of the provisional merit list for admission to 1st year of Diploma Courses, prepared by the WBSCT&VE&SD in order of the rank and who have passed Madhyamik or equivalent examination with English, Physical Science/Science and Mathematics with 35% marks (without rounding up) in aggregate excluding additional subject.
2. WBSCT&VE&SD will provide a panel in the council's website www.webscte.co.in under the caption “**Application for Decentralized Admission in Self-Financed Polytechnics**”, wherein the aspiring candidates will provide their details and the name of the Self-financed Institution in which admission is sought and also upload the scanned copies of the eligibility documents. The WBSCT&VE&SD will prepare **Institution-wise Merit List** based on the applications received through the portal and will send the same to the respective institution for taking admission against vacant seats.

3. The seats, if any remaining vacant after giving preference to the candidates mentioned under serial no. 1 above, may be filled up from amongst the **Institution-wise Merit Listed candidates** who have passed Madhyamik or equivalent examination with English, Physical Science/Science and Mathematics with 35% marks (without rounding up) in aggregate excluding additional subject, **without restriction in the marks obtained by the candidates in Mathematics and Physical Science/Science taken together.**
4. The students to be admitted in 1st year of Diploma Courses, must passed their qualifying examination from the Board/Council as mentioned in the information brochure of JEXPO-2020.
5. Candidates who have already taken admission in any Government Polytechnic through counselling are not eligible to take admission in the vacant seats of self-financed polytechnics.
6. Fee structure will remain unchanged as described in G.O. No. 528-TET(Poly) / 11C-08 / 2009 dated 29th July 2009.
