NOTIFICATION

The Council has decided to fill up the existing vacancy created out of last years vacancy after admission and vacancy that may get created if students fail or dropout in the 1st Semester through preferential Internal Transfer.

The Notice and the vacancy position will be put up in the Council Portal as well as the Institute Website. The Students will have the option to fill up there choices upto three options both interdisciplinary and inter college. The portal for student transfer (for Government Polytechnic only) will be opened from 19th August 2021 to 6th September 2021. You are therefore requested to inform all the students of 1st year of your Institute to apply online for transfer in the website webscte.co.in.

The transfer policy that the Council wishes to adopt is laid down below:

- 1) The college wise and course wise vacancies will be displayed in the portal for transfer of student for the entire period of time mentioned above.
- 2) While considering the options the allotment will be made on the Rank cum Merit basis on a 50:50 weightage, where Merit is the student's score in 1st semester and rank is the student's rank in JEXPO last year i.e.2020.
- 3) The allotment will be as per following preferences: -
 - A- For transfer to Institutes near to the residences
 - i. 1st priority to be given to all TFW students.
 - ii. 2nd priority will be given to PWD students
 - iii. 3rd priority will be given to Girl students.
 - B- For inter disciplinary transfer-
 - i. Students seeking transfer under category A will not be eligible
 - ii. Priority will be given on Merit, In case of tie, allocation will be decided on the category to which the candidate belongs in chronological order of ST/SC/OBC/GEN/Girl student.
 - iii. In case of further tie priority will be given to student who is older in age.

The Principals and Officers-in -Charge are to take maximum effort to ensure that this Notification gets wide publicity among students.
